

Low Income Geriatric Care Management Services



The **Care Management Solutions** program at **Lutheran Family Services** has been awarded funds by the **Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG)** to provide geriatric care management services to low income older adults in the Denver area. These services will promote quality of life for older adults wanting to live independently for as long as possible.

Our skilled care managers are experienced and knowledgeable in the field of aging and elder care, and offer care coordination to older adults experiencing difficult transitions and diminished functioning. We provide comprehensive assessments, present care options and resources, monitor safety and well-being, offer in-home counseling to address emotional needs, and support families in their caregiving role.

Call us if you know of an older adult who is:

- Gradually declining, but with added support and services, could improve functioning and remain at home.
- Having difficulty with the follow-up of a recommended service or treatment plan.
- Needing assistance navigating the maze of healthcare options and other resources available in the community.
- Isolated, depressed, or anxious.
- Grieving a significant loss, to the point that it is impacting daily life and overall well-being.
- Experiencing memory impairment, and needing assistance in planning for the future.
- Challenged by untreated mental illness that is now compounded by issues of late life, creating a precarious balance.
- Requiring so much more assistance from friends and loved ones that those caregivers are increasingly burdened and overwhelmed.



These funds, made available through the Older Americans Act, target low income older adults, age 60 and older. **There is no fee for service**, but contributions are welcome.
